Qualifying nonprofit organizations must have I.R.S. 501(c)(3) tax-exempt status.

The Grants Review Committee will consider grants to:

- Support effective, established programs;
- Help launch innovative, new programs; or
- Fund unique capital needs that will increase an organization's capacity.

Grants will not be made to underwrite or sponsor fundraising events or public relations events. Livingston Fund grants can be used to provide salary support.

Grant applications must be received via e-mail or postmarked by FRIDAY, MARCH 8; grant recipients will be notified no later than Friday, April 12.
